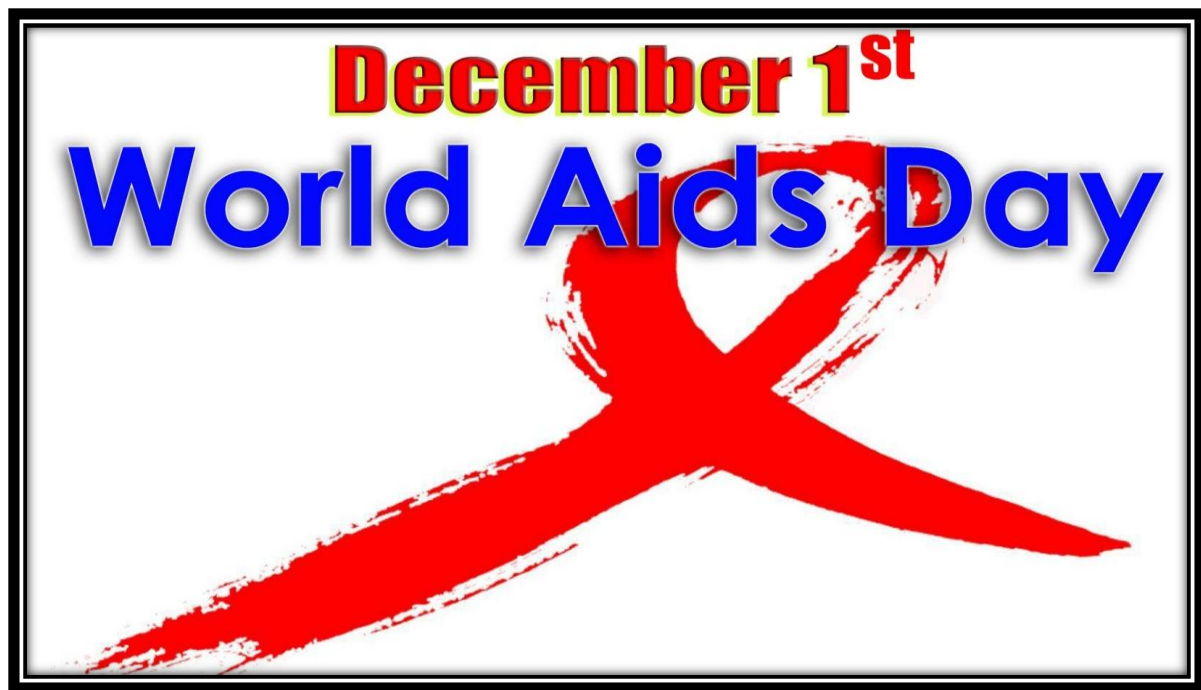

Objectives:-

- To bring awareness about HIV/AIDS
- To inculcate computer assisted learning
- To introduce e-learning among PG nursing students
- To help PG nursing students to counsel HIV/AIDS patient.

Activities performed:-

1. Series of Lecture cum discussion
2. E-learning with pre-test & post test
3. Role plays

Significance/need of the program:-

Sumandeep Nursing College organized series of lecture regarding HIV/AIDS. In this modern era, e-learning has become essential. It is also essential to know regarding HIV/AIDS and how one can manage post-exposure infection through prophylaxis. Moreover, INC also emphasizes on e-learning for PG nursing students.

Details of the program:-

Series of lectures were organized among PG nursing students. Mr. Kevin Christian, Assistant Professor, Department of Medical Surgical Nursing was appointed as a resource person who is also GFATM HIV/AIDS trainer. The topics that were covered are as follows:

- HIV/AIDS & disease progression

- Introduction to Anti-Retroviral drugs
- Post exposure prophylaxis
- Infection control in HIV/AIDS and its prevention
- Counseling of PLHIV
- Opportunistic infections in HIV/AIDS
- Syndromic Case management in STDs
- Role of nurse in taking care of PLHIV

These topics were covered by a.v. aids like videos, role plays, powerpoint presentations. Group discussions were done after every session. Pre test and post test was also done to assess the effectiveness of the programme. Tool for pre test and post test was used from questionnaire made by GFATM from the website of Indian Nursing Council. Certificates were also distributed among the students who had successfully completed the e-learning.

Conclusion: -

The training of HIV/AIDS was found to be useful among PG nursing students. Pre test and post test were conducted and students who had successfully completed the training received the certificates. PG nursing students has actively participated in the role plays and group discussion. They too have appreciated this type of e learning with systematic discussion.
