#### **<u>1<sup>st</sup> year BPT orientation program – Batch 2014-15</u></u>**

The orientation program for the 1<sup>st</sup> year BPT was organized by COP, SV on the 4<sup>th</sup> of august 2014. The program started with the 1<sup>st</sup> year BPT students joining in for the prayer and university song along with the whole college.

After the prayer, the students were made to sit inside the classroom along with the parents. Total of 106 students reported for the orientation on the first day. The class coordinators Dr Neha and Dr Saraswati, distributed the declaration form, hand book of physiotherapy and the personal details form which was read, signed and submitted by the students the same day. At 11 am the student coordinator Dr Megha started the program by welcoming all. The Principal along with the teaching staff as well as HOD Anatomy, Dr Gandotra and coordinator for physiology Dr Mahavir Rajput were present.

There was an address by the Principal who cordially welcomed all the parents and students. She congratulated the students for having secured admissions to one of the finest universities amidst such tough competition. The UG coordinator, Dr Kumar spoke on rules and regulations of the college. He gave details of the eligibility for university exams and in case of failure the exam reforms regarding ATKT

The HOD of Anatomy department and coordinator for Physiology also gave a brief introduction to the subjects.

Class coordinator Dr Neha M. spoke on the activities that a 1<sup>st</sup> year BPT student carries out throughout the year. She started with the number of subjects i.e. 8 including Anatomy, Physiology, Biomedical Physics, Biochemistry, Exercise therapy-1, Psychology & Sociology, Evidence Based Practice, then went to talk about the logbooks that the student has to maintain as part of daily records. She also talked about Physio Zest which was an annual cultural and sports function. Also a brief introduction to the mentorship program was given and the students informed that the mentors list would be put up very shortly.

Next the EBES coordinator Dr Kalpesh introduced EBES to the audience and how it will be of immense help to the students in their practice as physiotherapists. He went on to add that Sumandeep Vidyapeeth is the only university to have introduced EBES in its curriculum.

The library incharge Dr Arpita spoke about rules and regulations for the central library and the departmental library. She informed the students that she would facilitate the procedure for library membership by collecting the library membership fees of Rs 100/- and get it submitted to the library on the students' behalf.

The student coordinator Dr Megha gave a brief summary of the activities organized for the students as part of their overall development during the academic year. The program thus concluded and the students and parents were informed about the schedule for the next day i.e. orientation program organized by the university.

#### **MPT orientation – Batch 2014-15**

On 4<sup>th</sup> august 2014, college of physiotherapy organized the orientation program for the post graduate students of batch 2014-15. The academic year for the batch 2014-15 started on 4<sup>th</sup> august. On the same day college of physiotherapy organized the orientation program.

Presently 4 students have taken admission and out of them 3 students attended the orientation program and the fourth student, Bindi Sorathia joined on a later date. Post graduate class coordinator Dr. Kalpesh Satani welcomed all and read out the MPT curriculum and explained the rules and regulation of the Program. Principal Prof. Lata Parmar, Prof. Palani Kumar and Dr. Niraj Karamchandani were also present during the program.

## **EXTENSION ACTIVITIES**

#### Camp at Bahadarpur

A camp was organized by S Dhiraj General hospital at Bahadarpur village from 8<sup>th</sup> May to 15<sup>th</sup> May 2014. Consultants from various departments of Dhiraj General hospital (DGH) including Physiotherapy were a part of the camp. From Physiotherapy a faculty along with PG students, one from each specialty, were posted for the camp. The camp timings were 10-2 pm. On the first day of the camp, an inaugural ceremony was held with the Medical Superintendent of DGH, The Dean of SBKSMIRC, Dr GV Shah and Dr Chaudhary from Community Medicine Department being present for the inauguration. In total there were five patients who came for Physiotherapy, two stroke patients, one low back pain patient, one OA knee patient and one with adhesive capsulitis.

#### <u>New building - College of Physiotherapy</u>

In the continued efforts to provide a conductive environment for learning at Sumandeep Vidyapeeth, College of Physiotherapy's building underwent a complete renovation and reconstruction between December 2013 to April 2014. During this period the college was shifted to the Second floor of Department of Pharmacy as a makeshift arrangement and was functioning from there temporarily during that period.



College started to function in its renovated building starts functioning from May 2014. One more floor was added to the old building which was already having two floors (ground and first floors). New building of COP has facilities like huge Principal office, Basic and advanced subjects laboratories, Mini auditorium and Gallery type class rooms for UG and separate class room for PG with state of the art Audio-visual aids facilities. The entire building is covered with Wi-Fi facility with exclusive Wi-Fi facility at each gallery class room. The existing infrastructure facilities were further strengthened with addition of furniture that includes shared locker facilities for all the UG & PG students. An RO water treatment plant was installed at the terrace to provide clean and hygienic drinking water to all.


#### **Others:**
