Orientation program for First year BPT and First year MPT students 2015-16

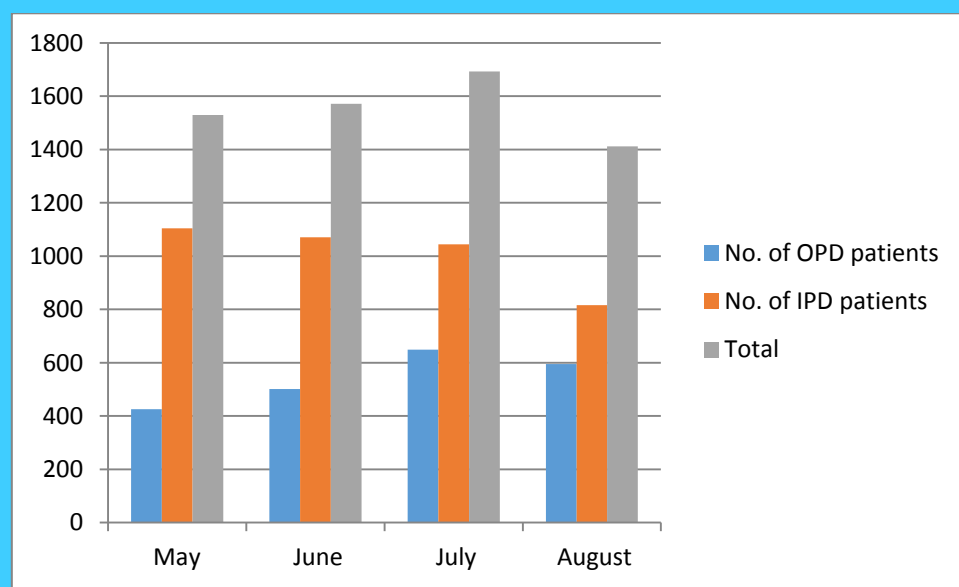
