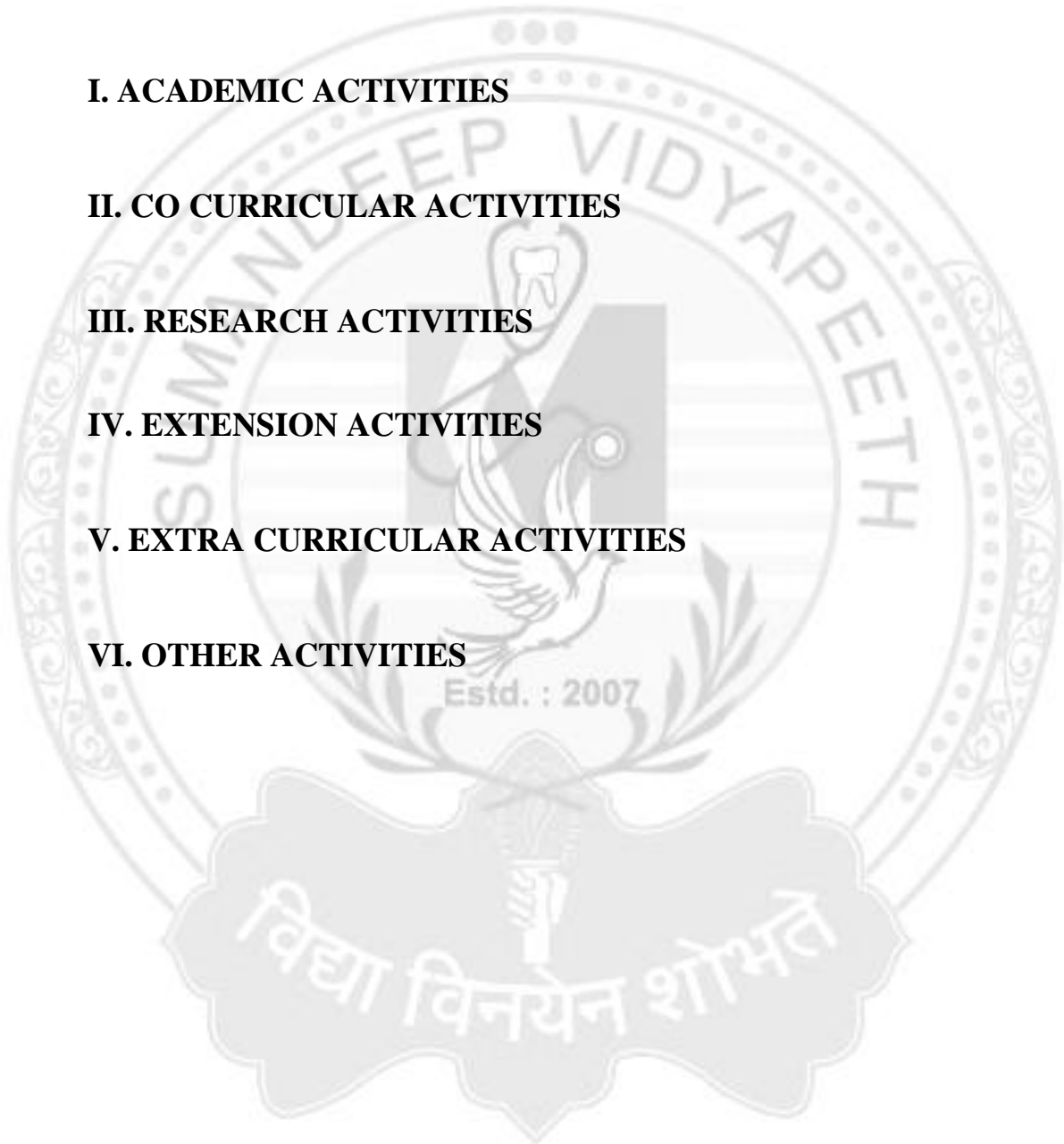

YEAR 2012

I – ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

1. CME on evidence based practice

CME on evidence based practice conducted on 1st March, 2012 for Interns and PG students. Dr. Sandeep Shah : Research Director and Prof. Lata Parmar, Principal were the chairpersons of this program. A total of 68 students (22 Interns and 46 Students) participated in this program.



2. State Level Workshop on Research Methodology & Data Mining

The College of Physiotherapy successfully organized the “State Level Workshop on Research Methodology & Data Mining” on 3rd October 2012. Over 70 Candidates out of which two who were pursuing their PhD from Gujarat University and rest of the candidates doing their post graduation attended this workshop. The students were from all around the state of Gujarat. The feedback received post workshop indicated that the speaker really kept the interest of the students in the talk & the language with which she interacted was simple & understandable. Overall rating of the workshop was good to excellent.



3. Convocation function

First Convocation of the Sumandeep Vidyapeeth was held on 11th January 2012. Following students were felicitated with Gold Medals for their academic achievement:

4. Second Internal Exams for UG and Feedback on Exams

II internal test conducted from 13th February to 22nd February, 2012. There were some changes made in practical examinations, these were mainly to partially structure the practical's, the changes were like: Lottery method used for assigning the exam question, Allotting equal time to all students.

And therefore feedback was taken from students post exams (II internal test). The feedback was in general good in brief the following point emerged:

- There should be a day's break in between exams.
- The changes were good. If there is a change in pattern of exams it should be informed prior to the exams and the students must be made to practice the same format.

5. Internship Completion

First batch of College of Physiotherapy under SV, (2007-08) batch finished their internship on 10th February, 2012. The internship completion and course completion was given to the students. Some students of our college under affiliation of Gujarat University also completed internship. The first time it was made compulsory for interns to submit 10 cases evaluation, present a seminar and give a clinical examination on live case.

6. Revision of Curriculum

The Board of Studies of Physiotherapy extensively reviewed the curriculum of BPT & MPT, to keep updated with national and International Standards. The whole curriculum was reviewed after the deliberations on Regulations/Ordinances. In MPT curriculum 02 electives were added.

7. Credit Based Evaluations

In order to enhance the quality of education and improve transparency Credit Based Evaluation system was planned and started from the year of 2012. Every hour to be allotted 05 credits.

8. College Transcript

College transcript was formulated for the 1st batch of Sumandeep Vidhyapeeth qualified completing their internship in February, 2012.

9. Students parents teachers meeting

Students parents teacher meeting was called on the 26th March, 2012 for both UG & PG. Presentation by the class in charges of all the four years of BPT & MPT was made, who showed the parents the overall results, results in each subjects and overall attendance of the students. following this individual counseling was done by the class in charge.

Feedback Almost 80 to 100% parents agreed that the meeting should be regularly arranged at least once/twice in a year, and also most of them preferred it to be held post exams.

10. Hand Book:

College of Physiotherapy has successfully printed a handbook for the fresher students. The handbook is intended to orient the student with the Vision and Mission of the college, briefly inform on the history of the University and its Founder, our Chancellor. It also informs the student on 'Physiotherapy', also to inform the student on the infrastructure facilities available and bit of campus life and the most important is the code of conduct and other rules and regulations.

11. Log Book:

Each year of BPT and MPT are instructed to maintain a daily log which have details such that the primary or the logbook 1 will list all activities undertaken or attended / participated whilst the 2nd, 3rd and 4th logbook will describe that what was learnt.

12. Orientation program for MPT

Two days of Orientation program was conducted on 16th July 2012 for newly admitted for PG students. After the dignitaries speech the students were delivered lectures on PG studies in Physiotherapy / method of training in Physiotherapy, INFECTIONS, HIV / AIDS, Hospital Policy, Management skills in PT, Basic Life Support training and Ethics in Human Research.

13. Orientation Program for BPT FOR 2 DAYS

The orientation program was this time jointly organized for all the faculty on 3rd August, 2012 between 10.12 noon

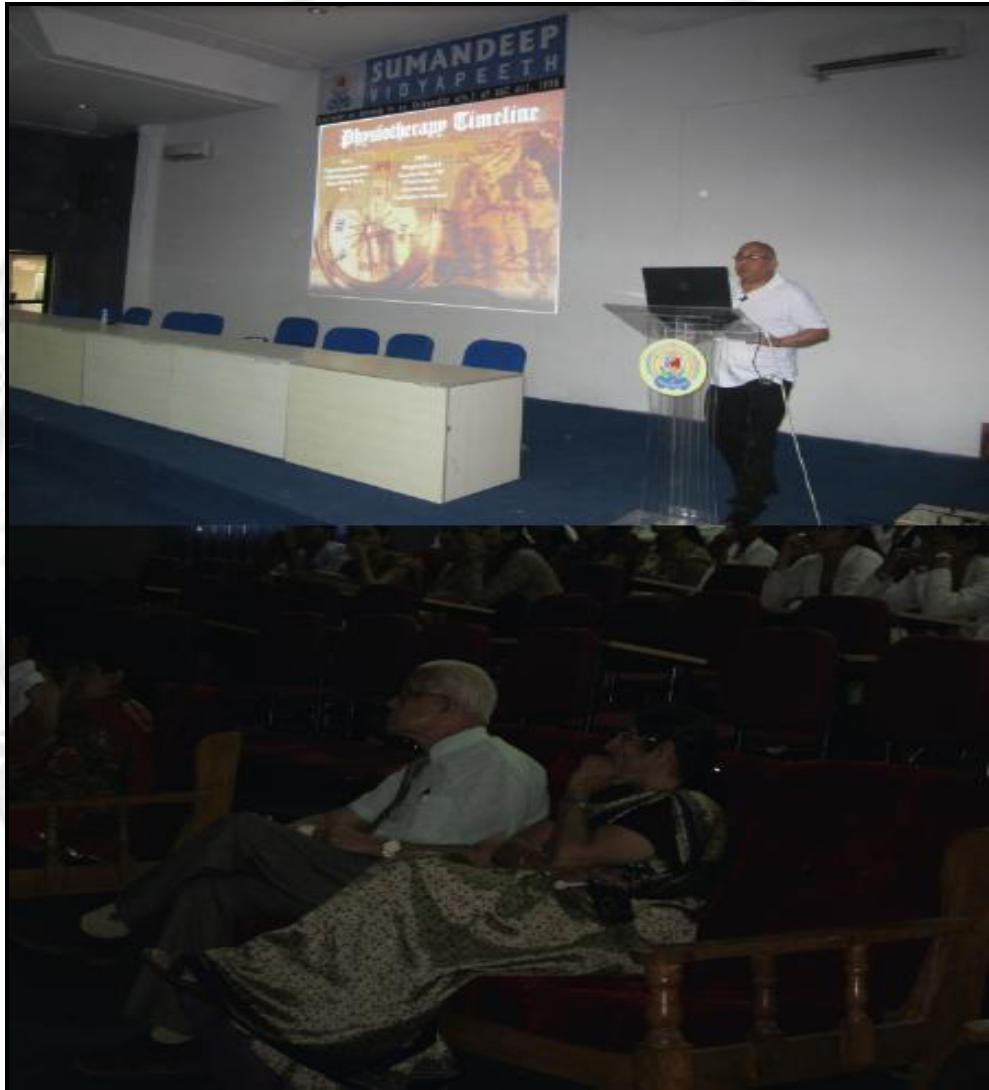
2. LRC orientation

1. Community Physiotherapy Services

A survey was conducted recently as college community Physiotherapy activity in the nearby 06 villages (picture) to assess the need of integrating Physiotherapy services in primary health care


The community physiotherapy services are continuing in the three villages (5-8 Km around the SV campus). Number of the beneficiaries are as shown in this table. the conditions commonly seen are Low back pain, knee pain, Frozen shoulder, heel pain, scoliosis, delayed milestones. No of patients treated were, in amodar 22, in ankhhol 21 and in khatamba 14

Community Physiotherapy services are continuing in the three villages and the patients treated were Amodar 18, Waghodiya 10, Pipariya 6.

2. Health Camp was organised on 8th September 2012 in College of Physiotherapy, Sumandeep Vidyapeeth. Patients were examined & treated by constlant Physiotherapist of our institute.




The overall conclusions was that

- 4) Planning for the future activities



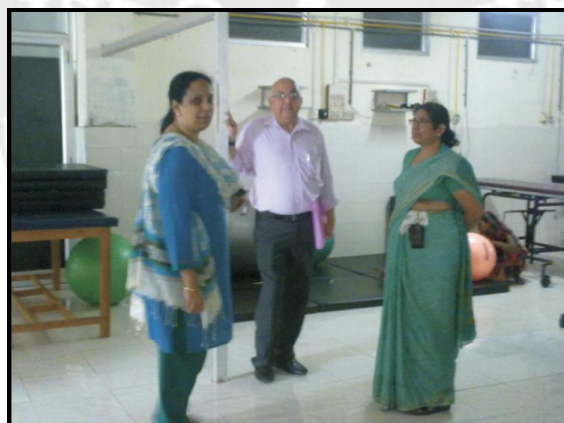
2. IAP Inspection

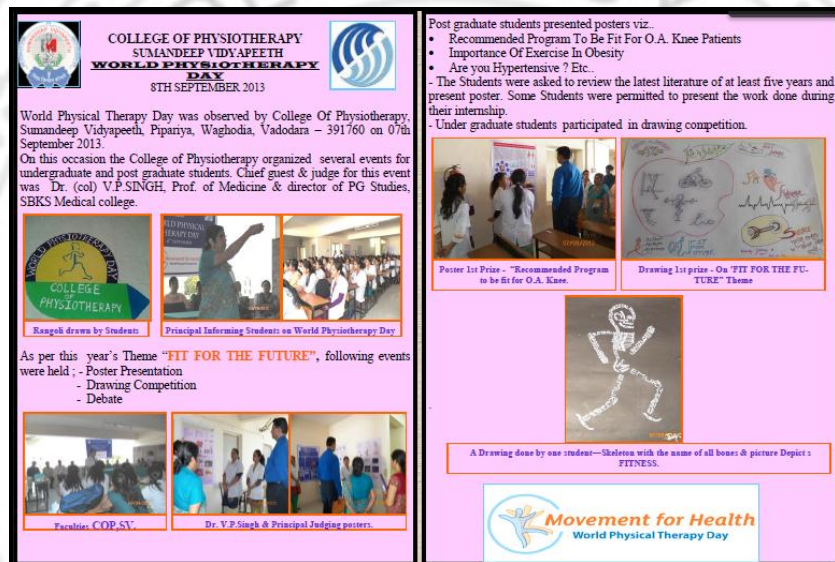


8. World Physiotherapy day
