**SUMMARY OF ANALYSIS REPORT ON

1. Introduction:

Feedback is an important element for improvement of any organization, especially teaching institution related to Medical / Dental and Allied health sciences. Comprehensive Feedback Cell of Sumandeep Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University collects feedback from all the constituent institutes namely:

- 1) Smt. Bhikhiben Kanjibhai Shah Medical Institute & Research Center (SBKSMIRC)
- 2) K. M. Shah Dental College and Hospital (KMSDCH)
- 3) Department of Pharmacy (DOP)
- 4) College of Physiotherapy (COP)
- 5) Sumandeep Nursing College (SNC)
- 6) Department of Management (DOM)
- 7) Department of Audiology and Speech Language Pathology (DASLP)

Departmental / Institutional Feedback coordinators under the guidance of Institutional / Central Comprehensive Feedback Cell collects feedback on various Curriculum aspects and courses from all the Stakeholders such as Students, Teachers, Employers, Alumni and Professionals. The collected feedback from all the stakeholders is analyzed and the outcome is used for improvement in Curriculum / Syllabus and other academic activities. The ultimate goal of Stakeholder's feedback is to get useful insights for the purpose of improvement in all aspects of teaching, learning and assessment.

2. Brief description of Procedure followed for collection of Feedback:

Structured Feedback form on Curriculum / Syllabus were distributed through Departmental / Institutional Feedback coordinators among all the Stakeholders such as Teachers, Students, Employers, Alumnus and Professional / Subject Experts visiting the institute as Examiners, Speakers, Delegates etc. through institutional feedback coordinators. All the Stakeholders were requested to fill the feedback forms about the curriculum depending on their frequency as prescribed by the Institution. A brief explanation was given on various parameters on which feedback to be collected. Stakeholders were requested to rate the Curriculum / Syllabus. From the Students and Teachers, the feedbacks were obtained after the completion of the Syllabus or before university examinations depending on examination pattern (Semester, Annual etc.). Whereas feedback forms were sent to the Employers who recruited our Alumni as an employee. They were asked to send us the filled feedback form. The Alumnus fills the Feedback forms after passing from the institute (Form A: at the time of registration with Institutional Alumni Association) and while visiting the institute after 2-3 years (Form B) after passing out from the institution. The Professionals were asked to fill the drafted feedback form during their visit to the institution either as an External examiner, Subject expert, Academician or as a Resource person / Speakers / Delegate etc. for various events like conferences, seminars, workshops, CDE programs etc. Filled forms from all Stakeholders were collected and were subjected to data analysis. The frequency of each of the responses for all the parameters were computed. The summary of all the feedback received from all the stakeholders were forwarded to Registrar for consideration, confirmation and execution. Recommendation / Suggestions were used for improvement in Curriculum / Syllabus and academic activities.

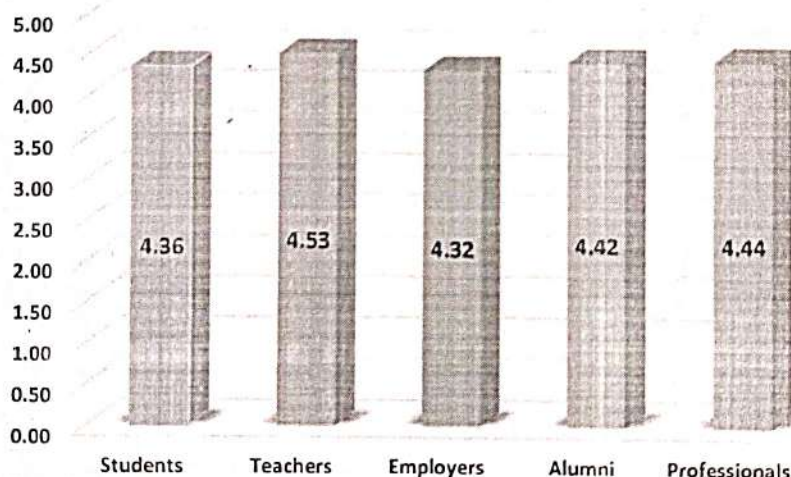
