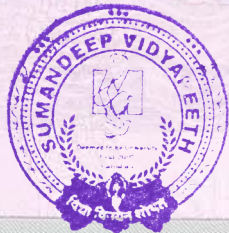

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is signed on 30th day of March 2021 at Gandhinagar (Gujarat).

WHEREAS the GUJCOST is interalia involved in popularization of Science and Technology and Promotion of Research and Development of Science and Technology in the State of Gujarat.

AND WHEREAS, GUJCOST is inviting the investigator to carry out the Research in Gujarat and for this purpose it is proposed to grant Rs. 1,65,000/- (In words: Rupees One Lakh Sixty Five Thousand only) approximately, Subject to the Terms and Conditions of this MOU.

DEFINITIONS:

- "Project" means the research work being carried on and pursued by the Investigator.
- "Commercialization" means and includes marketing, promoting, selling and distributing the Product including making arrangements of any and all kinds with any entity or entities anywhere in the world

- d) "Outcome" means a product, process or proto-type developed at the end of the project.
- e) "Force Majeure Event" means any act or event that prevents the affected Party from performing its obligation in accordance with the Agreement, if such act or event is beyond the reasonable control of the affected Party and such Party had been unable to overcome such act or event with the exercise of due diligence (including the expenditure of reasonable sums).

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants hereinafter contained, GUJCOST and Head of The Institution / Principal Investigator hereto agree as follows:

SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

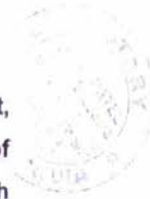
1. GUJCOST proposes to give grant to Head of institute Rs. 1,65,000 /- (In words: Rupees One Lakh Sixty Five Thousand only) to carry out research work on "Alcohol Free Non Toxic Hand Sanitizer Gel for Children" from "Dr. Nirmal V. Shah", of your Institute.
2. The Head of The Institution assumes financial and other administrative responsibilities of the project.
3. This Memorandum will remain in force for a period of three years from the date of its execution from the date of sign. The Memorandum can be extended for such periods or further periods by the mutual consent of the Parties. All such extensions shall be in writing. In case of multi-institutional project, formal agreement(s) between collaborating Institutions/Scientists should support the proposal.
4. International travel is not permissible under the sanctioned project.
5. The man power recruited for the project-should be paid as per rules of the institute and guidelines of the government.

6. The Junior Research Fellow (JRF) recruited under the project are encouraged to register for Ph.D. as per Institute/ University guidelines.



7. It is proposed to maximize the use of equipment. In this light, Investigator shall permit the use of spare or idle capacities of equipment procured under the project by Bonafide users (research work in other GUJCOST sponsored project or other projects of the institute).
8. GUJCOST shall review the progress of the project from time to time. Investigator/head of institute will be invited to present the progress of the project before the members of the monitoring committee known henceforth as Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) to ascertain the progress of the project and guide the investigator in implementing the project effectively. The recommendation of the committee may be conveyed to the investigator of institute for implementation. GUJCOST may also constitute a Monitoring Committee to visit the institution to review the progress of the project and to verify proper Utilization of grant-in-aid.
9. The Grantee institution shall observe all financial norms and guidelines as prescribed by the GUJCOST from time to time.
10. The investigator / Head of Institute should send the Acceptance letter once they receive the sanction order from GUJCOST.
11. The date of Receipt of the Bank draft of the first installment of the grant-in-aid by the institution shall be taken as the date of commencement of the project. The head of institution/investigator should intimate this date in writing/ by email immediately to GUJCOST.
12. A separate bank account shall be opened in a nationalized bank in the joint name of the investigator of the project and the head of institute and if it is not possible as per university/Institute act, the money shall be deposited in the university account maintaining a separate accounting system for the same.
13. The grant-in-aid will be utilized strictly for the specific project and should be exclusively spent on the project and within the time frame as specified in the sanction letter. Re-appropriation of funds from one stipulated head to another head is not permitted without prior approval of GUJCOST.
14. If the institution is unable to start the research work under the project within six months of the receipt of the grant-in-aid, the approval shall ipso facto lapse.
15. Any expenditure incurred prior to the issuance of the approval letter and after the expiry of tenure of the project is not allowed for any adjustment in the grant-in-aid.
16. Interest earned on the project fund, if any, shall be treated as a part of the sanctioned grant-in-aid and shall be used to procure equipment or for other purposes of the project approved by the GUJCOST.
17. The grant-in-aid released under the project cannot be spent on creating infrastructural facilities such as construction of roads and building, purchase of vehicles, air-conditioning etc.



...ing a collective decision, the share of researchers will be kept as a deposit by GUJCOST and no interest will be paid to the researchers.

28. If in relation to the disagreement amongst researchers for appropriation of the proceeds of IP, a period of five years elapses without any formal agreement amongst all researchers for sharing of proceeds as in para 13, then the researchers will forfeit their right to claim their share of IP.
29. The PI's are encouraged to publish research papers in reputed journals. It shall be the duty of the Investigator /head of institute to acknowledge GUJCOST in each and every publication made out of the research activity and send copy of the same to GUJCOST.
30. Subject the terms of this MOU, GUJCOST, and investigator /head of institute shall cooperate with each other and use reasonable endeavors implement the objectives outlines herein.
31. No amendment or modification of this Agreement shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties to the agreement or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this Agreement.
32. "Force Majeure Event" shall include without limitation the following acts or events: (i) natural phenomena, such as storms, hurricanes, floods, lightning, volcanic eruptions and earthquakes; (ii) explosions or fires arising from lighting or other causes unrelated to the acts or omissions of the Party seeking to be excused from performance; (iii) acts of war or public disorders, civil disturbances, riots, insurrection, sabotage, epidemic, terrorist acts, or rebellion. A Force Majeure Event shall not be based on the economic hardship of either Party. In case of any damage because of force majeure event, the project shall be repaired / commissioned at its own cost by the Institution of PI. Under such circumstances, GUJCOST and the Head of the Institution will arrive at a common conclusion of time line for the completion of project.

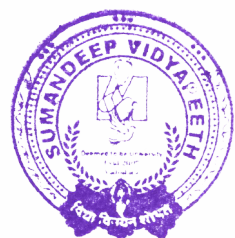

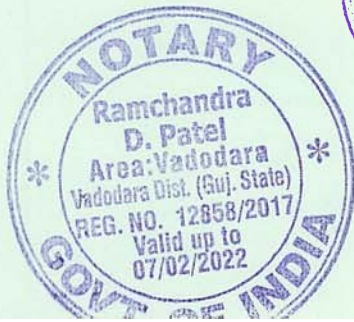
